

BJH TARDY POLICY

Tardy Policy

A student is considered tardy if they enter a class after the tardy bell has rung without a note or pass from a staff member. Repeated instances of tardiness will result in more severe disciplinary action, in accordance with the Student Code of Conduct.

Consequences for being Tardy

1. 1st-4th Warning from the teacher with parent notification either verbally or by written correspondence with documentation. Assistant Principals are alerted by teacher AFTER 4th tardy by means of the referral process.
2. 5th-7th 5 days of lunch detention
3. 8th-10th 10 days of lunch detention
4. 11 1 day of Saturday School
5. 11+ 2 days of Saturday School (7:30am-11:30am)

In the event that it is necessary for a teacher to keep a student at the end of the class period, the teacher will issue a hall pass so the student will not be counted tardy to his/her next class. This however, should be on an emergency basis and kept to an absolute minimum as a courtesy to the other teachers.

The policy will start over after semester.
